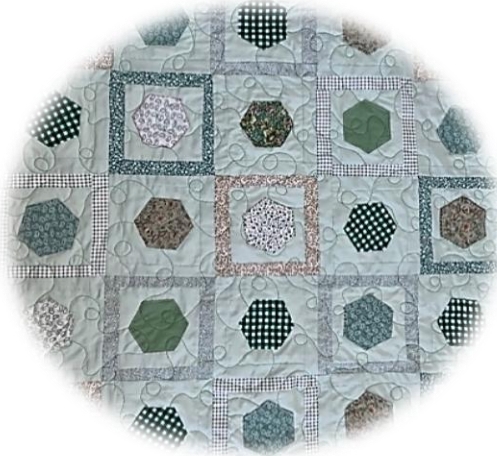




We had a lot of hexagons donated and stitched these into two quilts at our last meeting
