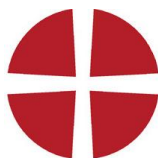

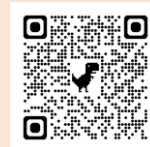

All you need to do is

Log on to easyfundraising.org.uk or add the easyfundraising app to your phone, ipad or tablet

Choose **Dore Methodist Church** as your cause by typing our name in the box (you will only need to do this once).

Every time you shop online, go via the easyfundraising page on your laptop, phone i pad or tablet and type in the name of the shop you want in the search box at the top.

You will then be directed to the familiar home page of your shop. You can then shop in your usual way, and the shop will pass on their donation directly to us! That's it!

If buying on-line is not for you perhaps you have friends or relatives who do shop in this way and would be happy to join in this scheme.
