Sunday Evening Services at Bents Green

Although many of these have not restarted after the lockdowns, we have maintained evening services at Bents Green. They are informal and friendly, with no fixed format. Often they are centred around a Bible reading, with either an explanation or a discussion, or both. Sometimes they look at issues such as Discipleship, Christian unity, Christian Aid, etc. We sing to a guitar most weeks, we have Holy Communion twice a quarter, and a service of Healing and Wholeness once a quarter. Our Worship Group leads a Praise Service for festivals. We share tea and coffee, and we start at 6.30. We already have people from 3 other churches joining us. If there is no evening service at your church, you are welcome to come along and see if ours are to your taste.

Just to mention that we also have a more traditional service on Wednesday mornings at 10 o'clock, and a Praise service with an address led by the Outcry worship band on the last Wednesday of every month at 7.30pm. Again, we share tea and coffee, and again, you are welcome.
